RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS

RESOLVED: That WHEREAS, an emergent condition has arisen with respect to paying salaries and wages for various City employees and various other expenses necessary to provide essential services to the residents of the City of Burlington prior to the final adoption of the budget and no adequate provision has been made in the 2015 temporary appropriations for the aforesaid purpose, and N.J.S.40A: 4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency temporary appropriation for the purpose above mentioned, and

WHEREAS, the total emergency temporary resolutions adopted in the year 2015 pursuant

to the provisions of Chapter 96, P.L. 1951 (N.J.S. 40A: 4-20) including this resolution total \$4,491,881.52 for Current Fund, \$ 511,713.00 for Water Utility and \$ 809,200.00 for Sewer Utility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S. 40A:4-20:

1. An emergency temporary appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the purposes found on attachment "A" attached.
2. That said emergency temporary appropriations will be provided for in the 2015 budget under the titles listed above.
3. That one certified copy of this resolution be filed with the Director of Local Government Services.
