

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the City of Burlington, for the Wayfinding Signage, Contract No. 2010-2, and will be opened and read in public at City Hall Municipal Offices, 525 High Street, Burlington, New Jersey 08016 on August 3, 2010 at 10:00 A.M., prevailing time.

The work includes the furnishing of all labor, material and equipment necessary or required to complete all work set forth in these Specifications and shown on the Plans. The estimated item quantities are summarized as follows:

Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the Specifications, Plans and Proposal by the ENGINEER at the cost of preparation thereof, \$35.00, nonrefundable, plus \$10.00 postage and handling if mailed. Checks shall be made payable to the ALAIMO GROUP.

This project is funded in whole or in part with funds provided by the New Jersey Department of Transportation under the Transportation Trust Fund. Awards shall be made subject to approval of the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

Bids must be made on the standard Proposal form in the manner designated therein and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, the name of the project, and the Bid Packet Number on the outside, addressed to the City of Burlington, and must be accompanied by a Certified Check, Bid Bond or Cashier's Check drawn to the order of the City of Burlington for ten percent (10%) of the total amount bid, provided said security need not be more than \$20,000.00. All bid guarantees shall be accompanied by an executed consent from an approved surety company, licensed to conduct business in the State of New Jersey, agreeing to furnish the required Performance and Maintenance Bond upon the award of contract.

The signed Proposal forms and bid security must be delivered to the place and on or before the hour named above. The accepted bidder must sign the contract within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award or forfeit his bid security. Bid securities will be returned to all but the three apparent lowest responsible bidders. All other bid securities will be returned within three days after awarding and signing of the contract and approval of the Contractor's Performance Bond, Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays excepted.

This contract is subject to the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27, Affirmative Action Regulations.

Sealed bids for this project are being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5 et seq.

The right is reserved to reject any or all Proposals, in whole or in part, or to make awards to such bidder or bidders who, in the judgment of the City of Burlington is the lowest responsible bidder and to waive such informalities as may be permitted by law.
