IDENTIFYING CDBG FAIR HOUSING OFFICER – 2026

WHEREAS, City of Burlington must make efforts to affirmatively further fair housing; and

WHEREAS, City of Burlington has reviewed various actions that would be acceptable to the New Jersey State Department of Community Affairs and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, City of Burlington will comply with:

- (a) The Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and regulations issued thereto; and
- (b) The Civil Rights Act of 1964, and the regulations issued thereto it; and
- (c) The Fair Housing Act of 1968 and will affirmatively further fair housing, and
- (d) The Age Discrimination Act of 1975 and with the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Megan Stanley shall be designated as the Fair Housing Officer for City of Burlington; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fair Housing Officer shall provide fair housing advisory services and assistance and referral advice to persons requesting such assistance from City of Burlington; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Megan Stanley will conduct a public information and outreach campaign to publicize the City of Burlington's fair housing services.
