Pot Hole Reporting Information

To report pot holes or sink holes on City of Burlington streets and roads please contact the Department of Public Works at 609-386-0754 x 1 or email publicworks@burlingtonnj.us. Please keep in mind that pot holes do occur more frequently in Winter months due to the cold temperatures and salting. Pot hole repair is usually completed during warmer, dryer weather when the materials and patches are able to bond properly to the existing surface. Please note not all streets and roads are the jurisdiction of the City of Burlington.

Please see information below for the list of Burlington County roads within the City of Burlington and the County Pot Hole Information for those areas.

Burlington County Streets & Roads within the City of Burlington:

Bordentown Road, Burlington Bypass, Columbus Road, Columbus Street, High Street (from Rt 130 S. to Route 541), Jacksonville Road, Morris Street, Mott Avenue, & Pearl Street (from the Assiscunk Creek to Burlington Twp.)
