To establish a dedicated tax program, the governing body of a county or municipality may ask voters to authorize a fund dedicated for any or all of the purposes listed below:



OPEN SPACE

The acquisition of lands for recreation and conservation purposes.



HISTORIC PRESERVATION

The acquisition, preservation, and restoration of historic properties, structures, facilities, and sites.



RECREATION AND PARK DEVELOPMENT

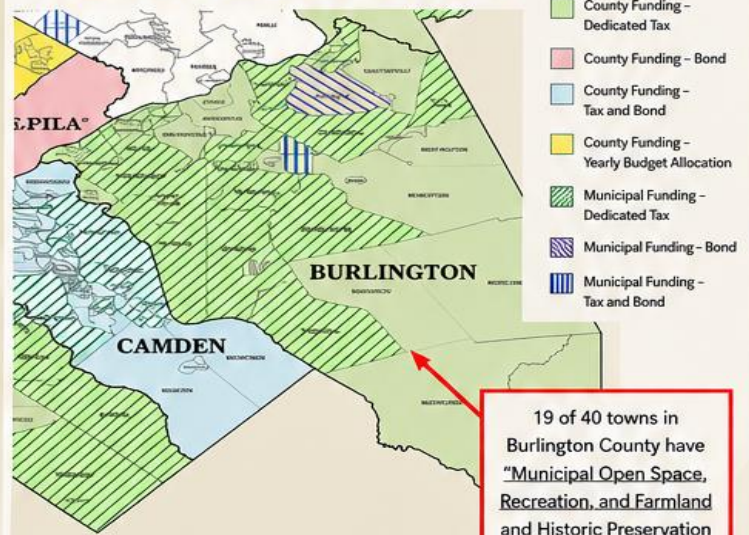
The development, maintenance, and operation of lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes.



PAYMENT OF DEBT

Payment of debt service on indebtedness issued or incurred by a municipality for any of the purposes set forth above.
